

Eva Nilson 07.05.1941–27.07.2017 in memoriam



Estonian lichenologist and ecologist, Ph.D. (dissertation “Biogeochemical ecology of epiphytic lichens in the conditions of pollution” defended in 1989 at the Institute of Plant and Animal Ecology in Sverdlovsk, now Ekaterinburg);

co-author of the two main keybooks of Estonian lichens, “Macrolichens of Estonia” (1994) and “Microlichens of Estonia (2004), and of the “Second checklist of lichenized, lichenicolous and allied fungi of Estonia” (1999);

co-author and contributor to several publications dealing with ecology and bioindication of lichens and plants;

senior researcher in the Tallinn Botanical Garden (1989–1993) and in the Institute of Ecology (1993–2001);

most recently worked as a quality specialist in the Microbiology Central Laboratory of the Estonian Health Board (2001–2012).
